## Applications Available for 2024 Property Tax/Rent Rebate

Eligible participants can receive a rebate of up to \$1,000 based on their rent or property taxes paid in 2024. The state program benefits eligible Pennsylvanians who are 65 years or older, widows and widowers 50 years or older, and those 18 years or older with disabilities.

The income limit is \$46,520 a year for homeowners and renters, and half of Social Security income is excluded.

My district office staff stand ready to help residents apply for their rebates FREE OF CHARGE. They should be prepared to provide all the necessary income, property tax or rental information required to process claims quickly and accurately. Applications are due by June 30.

## VETERANS SERVICES Available Monthly

Area veterans and their dependents with benefit questions or other issues can receive free assistance through my district offices.

**On the second Wednesday of each month, American Legion Veteran Service Officer Brian Stolarski is available to meet with veterans at my district office in Dallas from 10 a.m. to 3 p.m. Brian comes to my district office in Sugarloaf every third Wednesday, also from 10 a.m. to 3 p.m.**

Appointments are necessary and can be scheduled by calling **570-675-6000 (Dallas)** or **570-359-2138 (Sugarloaf)**. Veterans do not need to be an American Legion member to take advantage of this free service.
